ATTENTION PARENTS: Currently Type A (novel H1N1) flu is prevalent in our community and schools. According to the CDC, Georgia has widespread flu at this time. Cases of the flu has tripled since last week in Fayette County. Even though our students and staff are using good hand and cough hygiene we need your cooperation if your child should come down with flu-like symptoms. Keep your child home for at least 24 hours AFTER fever or flu-like symptoms are resolved WITHOUT using fever-reducing medication. 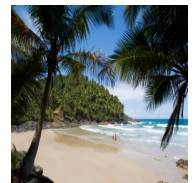
